In a world that rarely slows down,  
the Mikvah offers something different-  
an opportunity to pause and reflect.

For generations, this Mitzvah has been a quiet  
foundation of Jewish life, and this new Mikvah  
offers the chance to experience it in a space  
designed with intention: comfortable,  
luxurious, and deeply serene.

## WHAT IS A MIKVAH

Mikvah literally means a “gathering” of natural water. More than a ritual bath, it is a source of spiritual renewal that has been central to Jewish life since the beginning of our history.

Rooted in natural waters, like rain, springs, and oceans (or incessant Vancouver rainfall!), the Mikvah represents purity, transformation, and connection to something higher. It plays a role in many areas of Jewish life, including conversion, marking transitions, and the Taharah process, preparing a Jewish body for burial.



Most significantly, however, the Mikvah is at the heart of *Taharat Hamishpacha* (family purity).

Through immersion, a woman marks a moment of renewal, bringing holiness and depth into Jewish marriage and opening new channels of love and intimacy into her relationship.

between generations.

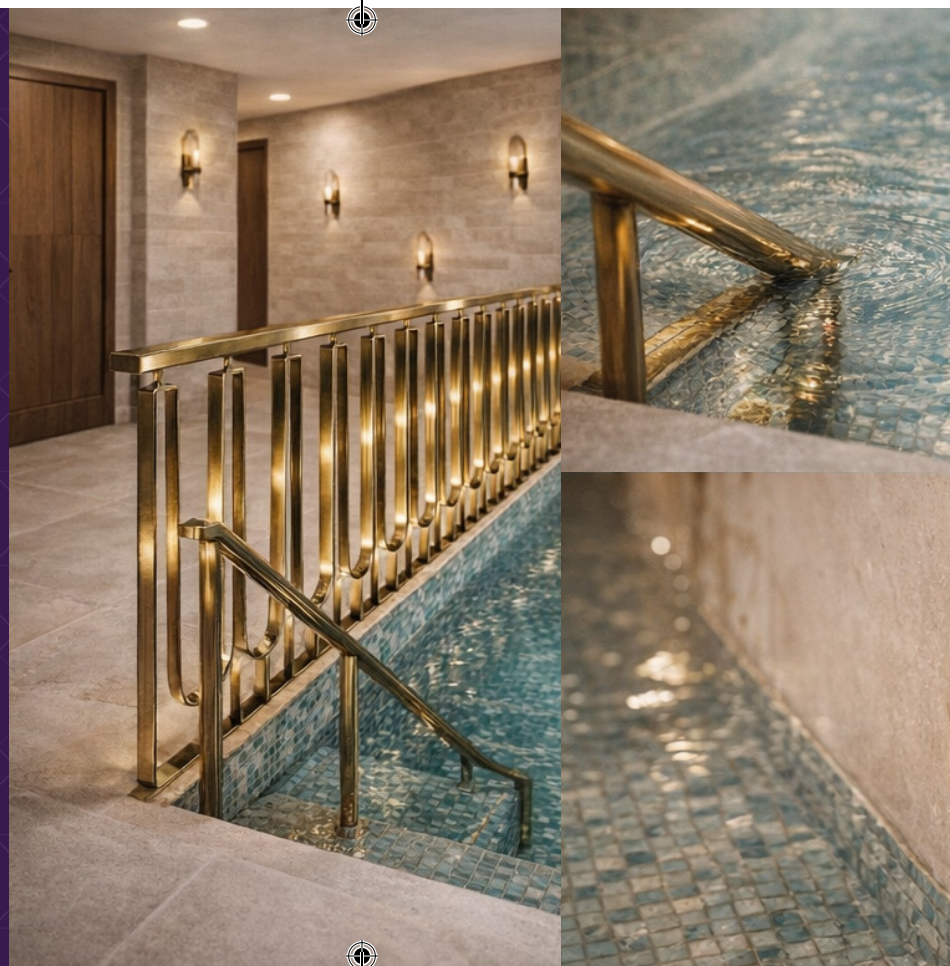
For this reason,

Thanks to the dedication and generosity of our community, construction of the new Mikvah is already well underway.

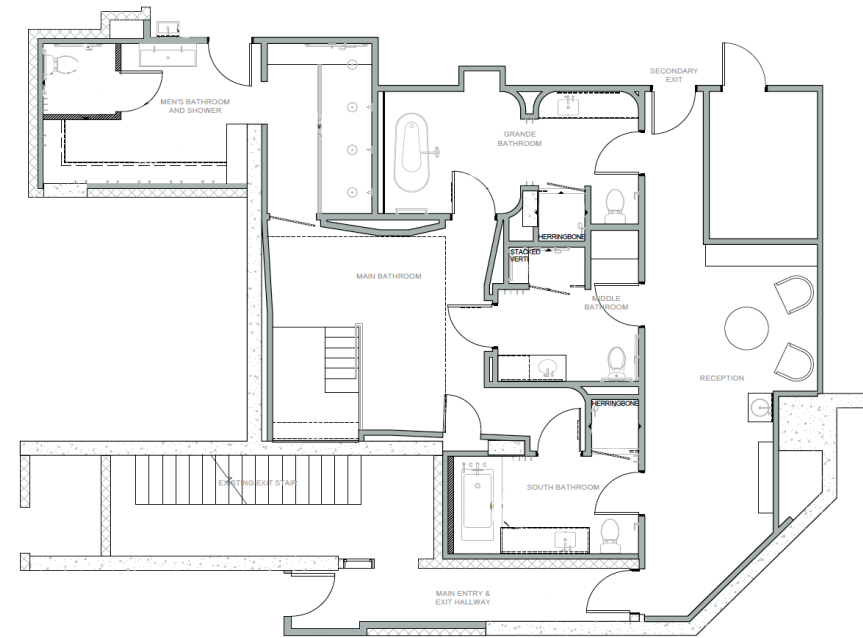
Each step brings us closer to opening the doors of this important community institution.
